- KF explained process of GPS locations, identification, bagging/tagging and removal of all artefacts for now, with replacement on site at the discretion of MBarbarrum people on completion of works.
- Changes To Ratch Permit Conditions and Advising CCC Members. (Permit condition 5 relating to low frequency noise deleted back in January, and increasing clearing of site from 58ha. To 73ha.recently amended)
 - KF presented information provided by RAC Hugh Sangster:
 - Ratch Permit changed to bring Consent in line with Qld Wind Farm Code of Practice. Delete C5: WF Code has o low frequency noise reference, so Permit brought into line with expectations for all other Qld Wind Farms, so no longer an applicable requirement.
 - Deletion of C15: Visual Impact of Substation and Rehab Plan RAC pointed out that the sub-station would not be visible from anywhere outside site. Qld Govt agreed no impact and a waste of time, \$ and govt resources to monitor removed.
 - Inconsistency in the Flicker requirements
 brought into line with Qld WF Code.
 - Amendment to conditions requires a formal process, defined in S369 of Qld Sustainable Planning Act (SPA), 2009.
 Formal process includes informing relevant Councils and key govt stakeholders and getting their approval for changes.
 - Clearing variation Formal process undertaken with Commonwealth Dept of Environment and Energy. Recognised that implementing best practice and mitigation strategies would require additional initial clearing to achieve, but would be effectively mitigated by:
 - Offset Plan and block size
 - Quoll Impact plan
 - Turbine Location Development Footprint Plan and
 - Their supporting: EMP's being followed.
 - All this information is available on website, which is updated as soon as



- available. This CCC meeting is first since all have been finalised to inform the CCC.
- SM Observation this application of best practice and such high standards could have implications for all other contractors in the region, being required to lift their standards to meet these.
- o JP concern of 'changing goal posts' and that commitments to date may change over time resulting in community having to accept lower /different standards.

 Example of community concern re recent changes to Windy Hill WF conditions. JP feedback of community concerns re 'sneaky behaviour' perception that TRC decision to change approved noise levels without sufficient / any consultation with affected landowner. Potential that RAC could apply for changes at MEWF should conditions change in future.
 - Discussion coverage / community concern as voiced in local newspapers comments sections.

 - SL why wasn't noise monitoring conducted for 12 months?
 - His group (TWAG) has requested that monitoring independent of RAC be undertaken to determine baseline levels over time.
 - Discussion all meeting supports that if a community group wishes to undertake independent monitoring it should be allowed to do so.
 - KF mentioned need to address privacy and safety issues; also that 2 lots of baseline monitoring had already been conducted around MEWF – according to AS/NZ standard – and deemed acceptable to all approving authorities and a background/ and operational noise limits

CCC to be informed of any future changed in conditions ASAP / when going up on website



had already been set for the site.

- SL requested CCC support application for RAC to pay for this monitoring out of Community Benefit Fund
 - KF informed all that purpose of CBF was not for this, and would not be appropriate.
 - SL asked meeting to support application for RAC to pay for independent monitoring.
 - KF suggested that RAC would not consider a 'bottomless bucket' request for funding – that any formalised written request would have to include a budget and probity controls proposed.
 - Discussion as to staging of request and what was 'baseline testing' and 'best practice' in this area; what was the legal requirement and what was the AS and did it align with the new Qld WF Code of Practice.
 - Request to RAC for approve an Extraordinary meeting of the CCC to be held as soon as RAC can obtain the services of an appropriately qualified Noise Expert who can attend and answer the CCC's questions about noise monitoring.

JP – requests explanation of difference between 35dB/ 40dB limits and background plus 5dB limits.

wishes to undertake independent noise monitoring and wishes to ask RAC for funds, it needs to formally write to RAC and clearly define the scope, budget and community benefits of the request.
